Dear Counsel:

Enclosed please find Petitioners' Amended Petition.

The only change is the addition of the Thirtieth Cause of Action at the end. Therefore, the numbering of the other paragraphs has not changed. I assume that when you serve your Amended Answers, you will only be adding new paragraphs at the end. If you do make any other changes, please identify them for us.

I do not think that this will affect the current schedule at all. I calculate the new timetable as follows:

Petitioners' deadline to amend Petition: service of State's
Answer on 5/25 + 5 days for mailing (CPLR § 2103(b)(2)) + 20
days (CPLR § 3025(a)) = 6/19

Service of Amended Petition = 6/18

State to produce FOIL Documents - 7/6

State's deadline to serve Amended Answer: service of Amended Petition on State on 6/18 + 1 day for overnight service (CPLR § 2103(b)(6)) + 20 days (CPLR § 3025(d)) = 7/9

ACR's deadline to serve Amended Answer: service of Amended Petition on ACR - 6/18 + 20 days (CPLR § 3025(d)) + 1 day (General Construction Law § 25-a) = 7/9

Petitioners' current deadline for service of Reply = 7/17.

Petitioners' statutory deadline for service of Reply to Amended Answers: 7/9 + 20 days (CPLR § 3025(d) + 1 day (General Construction Law § 25-a) = 7/30 (or later, depending on method of service of Amended Answers). However, so long as the changes contained in the Amended Answers are limited to answering the new Cause of Action, and the preceding paragraphs are not renumbered, we would waive the additional 13 (or more) days and serve the Reply on 7/17.
