In follow up to our meeting last week, attached is schematic drawing showing: the location of NYCO's current wollastonite mine in Lewis; other land which NYCO owns immediate to the south and southwest of the Lewis mine; and State-owned Lot 8.


We do not have a map showing the location of NYCO's land holdings at Oak Hill, but that location is apparently slightly less than two miles to the east of the Lewis mine. I can find out the specific town if that would be useful.

- . The schematic drawing outlines the location of Lot 8 in relation to the Lewis Mine in Essex County, New York.
- Approximately 50 acres marked in (Pink) represents the potential mining operation required in Lot 8 but is dependent on core drilling evaluations.
- Upon a successful acquisition, NYCO's property to the right of Lot 8 and from the pink line to the right, as well as Lot 8 would be donated to the state at the closure of the mining operation.
